PROTEINS – Proteins, broken down into amino acids, are the building blocks of muscle. DairyLeader First Choice Calf Milk Replacers start with the highest quality proteins and are then fortified with additional amino acids to maximize the calf's growth potential.

ENERGY – Fat provides a large percentage of the energy in a milk replacer. DairyLeader First Choice Calf Milk Replacers contain high-quality deodorized edible lard. Lesser quality fats are not as digestible and therefore provide less energy and may also reduce palatability.

MINERALS – Research has shown improved immune function when chelated minerals are included in the milk replacer. DairyLeader First Choice Calf Milk Replacers are supplemented so that half of the iron, copper, manganese and zinc are supplied in chelated form. Additionally, 100% of the selenium is supplied in the form of selenium yeast.

VITAMINS – DairyLeader First Choice Calf Milk Replacers are supplemented with high levels of vitamins, both fat soluble (A, D, E, & K) and water soluble (Vitamin C & B-complex) which are essential for proper growth and immune function.

DRUG OPTIONS:

Neomycin/Terramycin (Oxytetracycline) – for the control and prevention of scours.

Deccox (Decoquinat) – for the control and prevention of coccidiosis.

Bovatec (Lasalocid) – for the control and prevention of coccidiosis.

OPTIONS: We offer a complete array of additives and protein sources to suit your specific needs.

Some of the more common ones include:

BioMos – a product derived from yeast that helps prevent diarrhea.

DFMs – direct fed microbial bacteria that are beneficial to gut health.

Wheat/Plasma – alternative protein sources.

MIXING AND FEEDING INSTRUCTIONS

Into 2 quarts of warm (110° F) water, add 1 cup (8 oz) of milk replacer powder and mix thoroughly. For larger batches, mix 1 pound of milk replacer per gallon of water. Feed at a rate of 2 to 3 quarts per 100 lbs. of body weight twice daily. For best results, provide free choice water and starter grain at all times. Calves can be weaned once they are consuming 1½ lbs. of starter for 3 consecutive days.

GOOD MANAGEMENT PRACTICES

- 1) Feed 4 quarts (1 gallon) of high quality colostrum as soon as possible after birth, preferably within the first hour. Feed an additional 2 quarts of colostrum at 6-12 hours of age.
- 2) Feeding and mixing equipment should be cleaned and sanitized after each use.
- 3) Clean, fresh water should be available at all times.
- 4) High quality texturized calf starter should be available free choice after 4 days of age.
